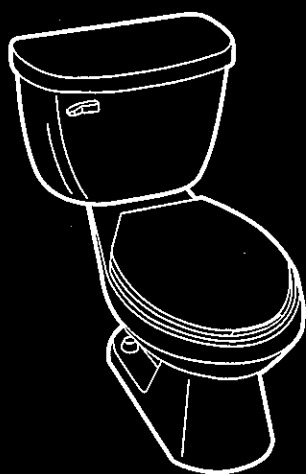
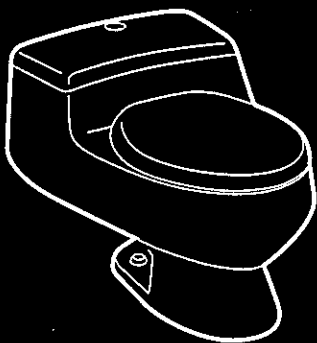

REMOVING OLD TOILET

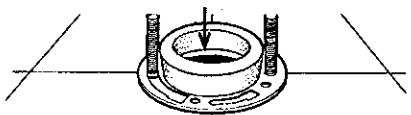
- 1 Turn off the water supply, then flush to empty tank. Use a sponge and basin to pick up any water left in the tank or bowl.
- 2 Disconnect the supply line from the toilet tank.
- 3 Disassemble tank from bowl by removing lock nuts from the underside of the tank.
- 4 Pry off the bolt caps, remove nuts that secure the toilet to the floor. Use a rocking motion to remove the old toilet.
- 5 Scrape the old wax gasket from the floor flange.

ATTACHING TOILET BOWL TO FLOOR FLANGE

- 1 Ensure flange is level and flat with finished floor.
- 2 The floor flange must be properly installed. It must be the correct distance from the wall. It must be flush with the surface of the floor.
- 3 The correct distance, measured from the wall to the centerline of the floor flange should be 12" (30.5 cm).
- 4 The top surface of the floor flange must be flush and level with the surface of the finished floor. Check the distance and the level with a straight edge ruler.

SETTING THE BOWL

- 1 Clean any debris out of the flange.
- 2 Install the mounting bolts into the side slots of the floor flange. The bolts should be inserted into the slots, bolt heads down, threaded shank pointing upward.
- 3 Remove the toilet bowl from the carton. Sit the bowl upright on the floor, away from the floor flange.
- 4 Put the wax seal ring in place, centered on top of the floor flange. Push the wax ring down into place (the mounting bolts will protrude upward at the side of the ring).



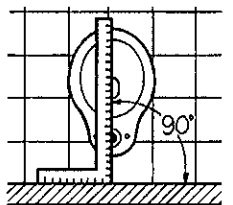
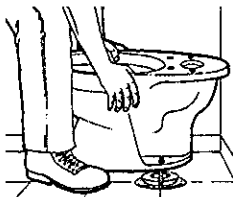
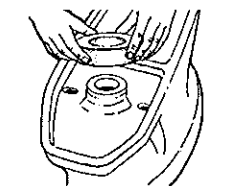
- 5 Alternate way is to place wax ring on the 'Horn' of the bowl (bowl shown upside down).

- 6 Straddle the toilet bowl, lift it and carry it over the flange. Lower it straight down onto the wax seal ring. Make sure the bolts emerge up through the holes in the base of the toilet bowl.

Note: For a one-piece unit, it is recommended that two people lift the bowl and place it on flange.

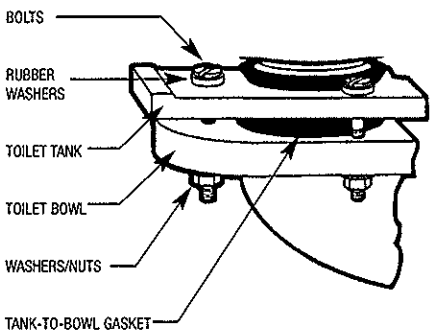
- 7 Push down all around bowl to seal onto wax ring.
- 8 Apply your weight to push the toilet bowl onto the wax seal ring. Press down evenly, all the way around the bowl rim.

- 9 Make sure the toilet bowl is aligned perpendicular to the wall with a carpenter's square. Adjust alignment if necessary.
- 10 Install the bolt cover retainer plates, washers and nuts. Tighten finger tight, then use a wrench to snug the nuts. **DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN** with the wrench—damage or fracturing of the base of the toilet may occur.

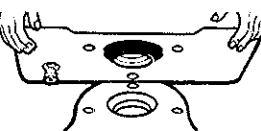


ATTACHING THE VITREOUS CHINA TOILET TANK TO THE TOILET BOWL FOR TWO PIECE MODELS

(Does not apply to a one-piece toilet)

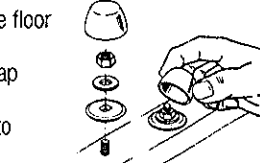
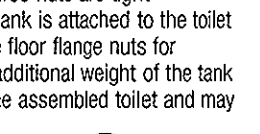
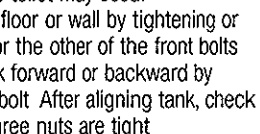
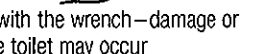
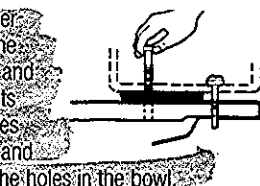


- 1 Place the tank-to-bowl rubber gasket onto the locknut on the flush valve shank against the bottom of the tank. (Be sure the locknut is tight).
- 2 Place the tank in position on the bowl. Be sure to align holes in the bottom of the tank with the holes in the bowl.



REMOVE STEP THREE

- 3 Screw the rubber washers onto the mounting bolts and insert these bolts through the holes inside the tank and down through the holes in the bowl.
- 4 Assemble the washers and nuts in pairs and screw onto bolts protruding from the underside of toilet bowl ledge.
- 5 Tighten all the nuts finger tight. Carefully tighten them with a wrench to make leak proof seal. **DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN** with the wrench—damage or fracturing of the toilet may occur.
- 6 Align tank with floor or wall by tightening or loosening one or the other of the front bolts. You can tilt tank forward or backward by adjusting back bolt. After aligning tank, check to be sure all three nuts are tight.
- 7 After the toilet tank is attached to the toilet bowl, check the floor flange nuts for tightness. The additional weight of the tank has added to the assembled toilet and may require careful tightening of the floor flange nuts.
- 8 Snap the bolt cap covers onto the retainer plates to finish the job.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

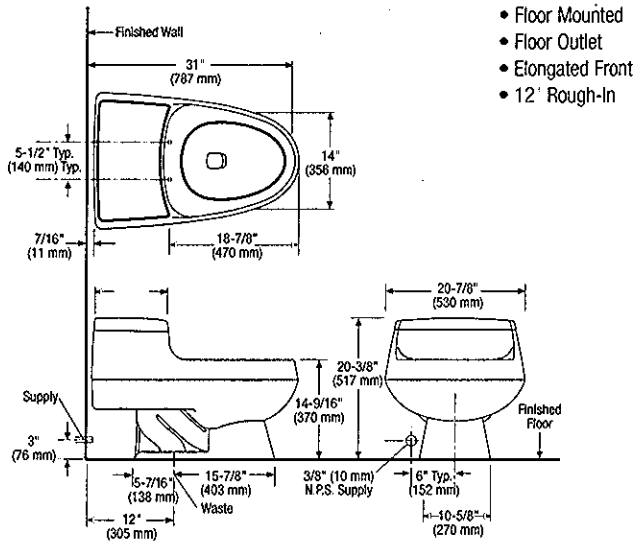
The outside surface of your china fixture can be cleaned with mild soap and warm water using a soft cloth or sponge. Do not use an abrasive cleaner or solvent of any kind. A toilet bowl cleaner can be used to clean the surfaces of the toilet bowl.

WARNING: Do not use an in-tank type bowl cleaner in your toilet. In-tank cleansers containing chlorine (calcium hypochlorite) can seriously damage fittings in the tank. Mansfield Plumbing will not be responsible for any tank fitting damage caused by the use of cleaners containing chlorine (calcium hypochlorite).

WINTERIZING TIP

If you choose to "winterize" the bowl, first follow the winterizing instructions for the pressure vessel found in the "Owner's Service Manual" - 503 and 504. If not found, go to www.flushmate.com under document library/service manuals. After the pressure vessel has been winterized, slowly induce 3 quarts of anti-freeze to the bowl (be careful not to cause the bowl to flush). Be sure to reconnect all the fittings when putting the toilet back in service.

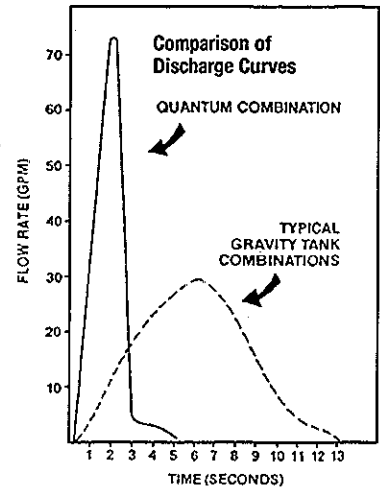

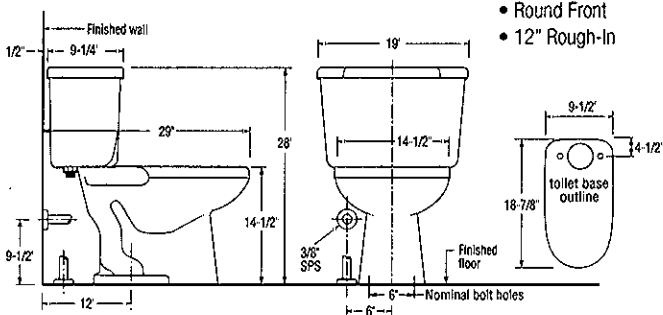

- 6 Prestigio 4, Quantum and QuantumOne toilets harness the pressure of the incoming water, contain the air pressure that's developed, then when flushed, release the "built-up" water and air to effectively get more flush from less water
- 7 It has been tested thoroughly against ANSI/ASME Standards for toilet performance. Quantum using less than 1.6 gallons and Prestigio 4 and QuantumOne using only 1.0 gallon greatly surpass all compliance requirements written for toilets
- 8 Average toilet usage is approximately 3.8 gallons per person per day for domestic use. Hotel and motels can save approximately 4,500 gallons per room per year

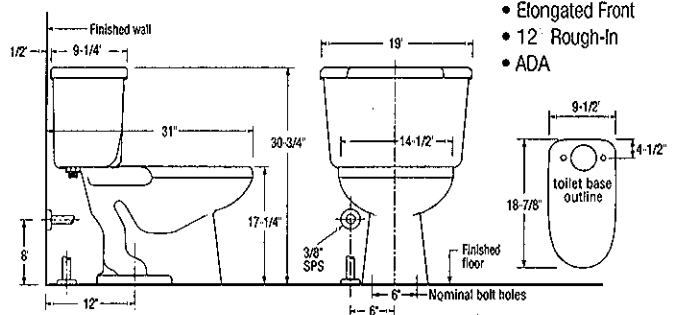

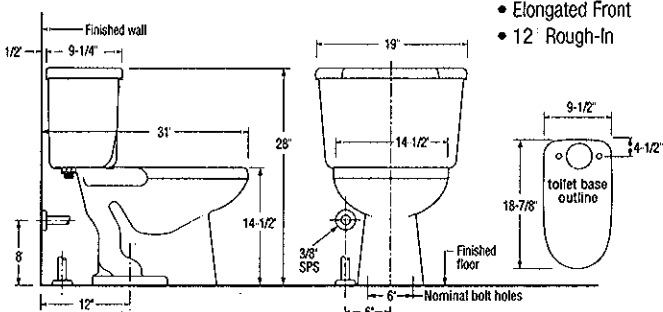

Condition: Water runs and will not shut off

A run-on condition may be caused by insufficient water pressure, an improperly adjusted Flush-Valve Cartridge, or a clogged inlet-screen. Refer to "Installation Requirements" for recommended minimum pressure. (See "Points to Remember" for a simple method to determine whether your water pressure is adequate) If sufficient water pressure has been verified and the toilet continues to run-on, the following steps may be required:

1. Make sure the water supply valve is fully open.
2. Check the actuator adjustment. The Flushrod (I) or pushbutton (See page 5, Flush Actuator Adjustment) should not interfere with the actuator. The proper clearance should be approximately 1/16" when the pushbutton or flush-handle is stationary. On push-button type fixtures, loosen the set-screw on the actuator (see F on the component list) and rotate the actuator up (counter clockwise) or down (clockwise) until the proper clearance is obtained. For flush-handle fixtures, observe the clearance (See Fig 1). If necessary, adjust the actuator to allow for proper clearance. When proper clearance is obtained, tighten the setscrew.
3. Remove, examine, and reinstall the Flush-Valve Cartridge (3)
 - a. Turn off the water supply valve and flush the toilet to relieve the pressure.
 - b. Remove the Flush-Valve Cartridge using the handles of a pair of pliers (See Fig. 2). Turn the Flush-Valve Cartridge counter-clockwise until you can lift it out of the **FLUSHMATE®** tank. On flush-handle fixtures, disengage the Flushrod from the handle-linkage and flip it away from the Flush-Valve Cartridge. It is not necessary to loosen the retainer clips (See Fig 3).
 - c. Examine the exposed O-rings on the Flush-Valve Cartridge for obstruction or damage. If the O-rings are damaged, the Flush-Valve Cartridge should be replaced (See Fig 4).
 - d. Insert the Flush-Valve Cartridge into the **FLUSHMATE®** tank and thread it clockwise into place until one (1) black thread (on the **FLUSHMATE®** tank) is showing above the Flush-Valve Cartridge (See Fig 5). Fully open the water supply valve and continue to thread the Flush-Valve Cartridge clockwise, 1/4 turn at a time, pausing briefly between each 1/4 turn, until the water stops running into the toilet bowl and the **FLUSHMATE®** tank pressurizes.
 - e. Reinstall Flushrod and handle-linkage.
4. Check Inlet Screen
 - a. Turn off the water supply valve.
 - b. Flush the toilet to relieve the pressure.
 - c. Disconnect the water supply line from the Supply Shank (A) (See Fig 6).
 - d. Examine the inlet-screen and remove anything that may be blocking the flow of water into the **FLUSHMATE®** tank. The inlet-screen can be removed by inserting a small pointed object (such as a large paperclip or the blade of a pen-knife) into the Lower Supply Shank and working the inlet-screen loose (See Figs 7a, 7b, 7c). The inlet-screen easily snaps back into position by pushing it upward into the Supply Shank with your fingertip (See Fig 7d).
 - e. Reattach water supply line and fully open water supply valve.

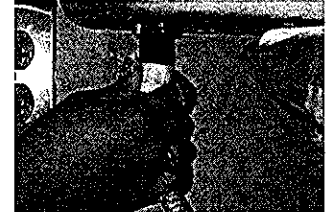

Condition: Weak, incomplete, sluggish, or no flush

Inadequate water pressure, an improperly adjusted Flush-Valve Cartridge, a clogged inlet-screen, or insufficient air-draw may cause a weak, sluggish, or no flush condition

1. Make sure that the water supply valve is fully open
2. Check for proper installation/adjustment of the Flush-Valve Cartridge (See Step 3, "Water Runs and Will Not Shut Off")
3. Turn off the water supply valve
4. Flush the toilet to relieve the pressure
5. Disconnect the water supply line from the Supply Shank (A) (See Fig. 6)
 - a. Examine the inlet-screen and remove anything that may be blocking the flow of water into the FLUSHMATE® tank. The inlet-screen can be removed by inserting a pointed object (such as a large paperclip or the blade of a pen-knife) into the lower-supply shank and working the inlet-screen loose (See Figs 7a, 7b, 7c). The inlet-screen easily snaps back into position by pushing it upward into the Supply Shank with your fingertip (See Fig. 7d)
6. Examine the Air Inducer (D) for obstruction or damage. (See Fig. 8)
 - a. Make sure the water supply valve is turned off and the toilet has been flushed to relieve the pressure.
 - b. Remove the Air Inducer Cap. (See Fig. 9)
 - c. Remove the Duck-bill Valve from the Air Inducer Cap (See Fig. 10). The flat "lips" of the Duck-bill Valve should open fully when the square sides are squeezed together (See Fig. 11). Rinse any obstruction or mineral deposits from the Duck-bill Valve. If the Duck-bill Valve is damaged, it must be replaced.
 - d. Insert the Duck-bill Valve into the Air Inducer Housing (See Fig. 12)
 - e. Put the Air Inducer Cap back on, and tighten finger-tight only (See Fig. 13)
 - f. Reconnect the water supply line and fully open water supply valve
7. Check Air Inducer for sufficient air-draw. Place a small amount of water (two to three drops) over the hole on top of the Air Inducer Cap (See Fig. 14) and flush the toilet. If the Air Inducer is working properly, the water will be drawn in (See Fig. 15)
8. Check the Flush-Valve Cartridge for leaks. Pour a small amount of water into the Cartridge Housing area (See Fig. 16). If bubbles are coming from the center or the edge of the Flush-Valve Cartridge, it should be replaced

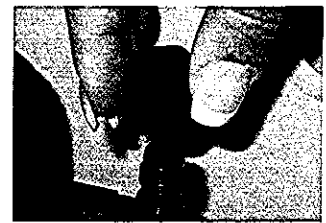

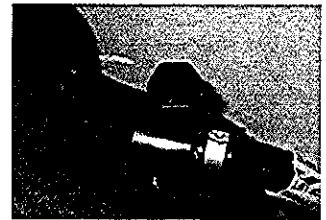

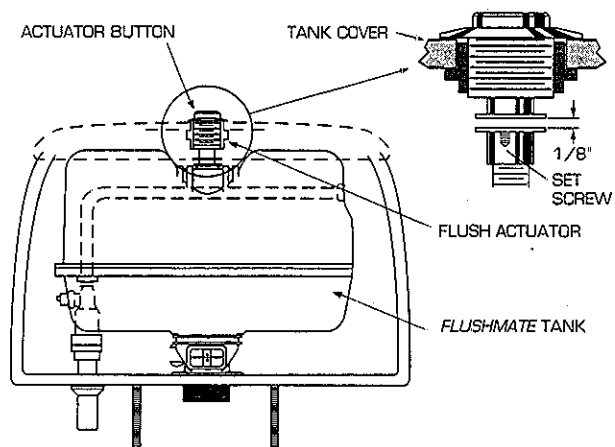
Condition: Vacuum Breaker Leaking

If the Vacuum Breaker (E) is leaking, it is likely that the water pressure is insufficient or that there is insufficient flow due to a plugged inlet-screen in the Lower Supply Shank. As required by the fixture manufacturer, the pressure range is 25 to 125 psi for the 503 series and 35 to 125 for the Series 504

Flush Actuator Adjustment (Tank 122)

NOTE: The tank is factory-adjusted for consistent, safe seal depth in the bowl after flushing. Field readjustment is not required. The refill is preset and locked.

1. Flush actuator height may be adjusted to assure positive operation of the actuator button
2. Be sure tank cover is in place
3. Lightly press actuator button down until resistance is felt when contact is made with the top of the flush actuator. Travel should be approximately 1/8" (3 mm) for normal operation
4. When necessary remove cover, loosen setscrew in actuator cap and turn cap to increase gap (clockwise) or decrease gap (counterclockwise)
5. Tighten setscrew securely after adjustment. Replace tank cover and recheck

- A small amount of water may be present in the bottom of the china holding tank. The potential for odor can be eliminated by adding a cup of white vinegar to the china holding tank. The white vinegar will act as natural disinfectant
- Your water pressure is adequate if your water supply line will yield one or more gallons of water within thirty (30) seconds for Quantum fixtures and two gallons of water within thirty (30) seconds for QuantumOne fixtures.
